SCHOOL AND COMMUNITY:

St. Mary's High School, Kathmandu, was established in 1955 under the management of the Sisters of the Congregation of Jesus founded by an English lady, **Mary Ward**, in 1609. It is an international institution especially devoted to the education of young girls. This institution is opened to girls of all communities, irrespective of status, caste, creed and religion. The school imparts not only academic education to girls but also helps them to form an integrated personality by developing in them a strong character, love of truth, respect, loyalty, a sense of justice and the necessity for honesty and hard work. This will make them an honor to womanhood and a source of happiness and blessing to all with whom they come in contact with.

Physical training, social and cultural activities and other extra-curricular activities are given adequate place in the student's education to make them disciplined and worthy citizens. Value education taught to all students aims at inculcating in them right values and attitudes.

CURRICULUM:

In 1995, at the request of the Higher Secondary Education Board (HSEB), Sister Eugenia pioneered the Higher Secondary Section Grades XI and XII of St. Mary's to give the students an opportunity to continue their studies after the tenth grade at St. Mary's. Thus, the Plus 2 (Grades XI and XII) section was established and there were 65 students in the first batch.

Every year almost 180 students graduate from three different faculties – Science, Commerce, and Humanities.

The courses offered in each faculty are as follows:

SCIENCE: Biology, Chemistry, Physics, Botany, Mathematics, English, Nepali, Value Education

COMMERCE: English, Nepali, Business Studies, Economics, Accountancy, Business Mathematics, Computer, Value Education

HUMANITIES: English, Nepali, Sociology, Mass Communication, Rural Economics, Major English, Value Education.

The examinations are conducted at the end of each academic year by the Nepal Education Board (NEB).
